You are kindly requested to read this information and all attachments very carefully and please note that the use of Live Scoring System is as per Directives obligatory for each home Association.

1. Delivery of Nittaku balls

As you know according to the Directives of the European Championships the ball to be used shall be Nittaku Premium+ *** white.

The delivery will be done by Donic soon to the official addresses of the Associations (please see attached excel file) according to following quantity:

- Azerbaijan, Denmark, Estonia, Israel, Italy, Lithuania, Norway, Turkey - 5 home matches each 5 x 48 balls per match = 240 (20 dozens)
- Austria, Belarus, Belgium, Bosnia Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech, England, Finland, Greece, Hungary, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Russia, Scotland, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Ukraine - 4 home matches each 4 x 48 balls per match = 192 (16 dozens)
- Ireland, Kosovo, San Marino - 3 home matches each 3 x 48 balls per match = 144 (12 dozens)
- Cyprus, Germany, Montenegro, Romania - 2 home matches each 2 x 48 balls per match = 96 (8 dozens)

Please note that these balls should be used exclusively for the European Championships matches during the whole year and there will be no replacement sent by Donic or ETTU again.

2. Live Scoring System

Please note that the use of Live Scoring System is obligatory for each match, therefore you are kindly requested to read attached Information and Guidelines provided by our partner UNAS very carefully. Please also note that there is no technical support right before and during matches so all tests and settings have to be done previously during weekdays and office hour times, i.e not later than 4 p.m. Technical assistance can only be provided by Unas (Oliver Zech oliver.zech@laola1.tv) not by ETTU. First test shall be done not later than Friday, **9th February 2018**. Second test shall be done not later than Friday, **16th February 2018**.

Live Streaming

As mentioned in the Directives the ETTU holds the non-exclusive rights for Internet TV and Internet Live Streaming for the matches produced by the home Association of the match.

ETTU grants the home Associations the permission to produce and broadcast a signal for internet live streaming but the home Association has to guarantee a geo-block (if technically possible) of the streaming on its national territory and has to provide the ETTU Media Partner with the signal free of charge.

Please find enclosed the technical instructions for providing ETTU's Media Partner (Sportradar) with the signal free of charge.

Sportradar will make sure that the match(es) will also be available worldwide on ETTU.tv.

Please note that ETTU cannot provide answers to technical questions. Please consult Sportradar (contacts to be found in the attachment) at least two weeks before the match date.
